

Beep. Boop. Definitely not a turkey.

Your original print, cut & disguise kit. Make a character. Tell a story.

1 Print at actual size

Select LETTER paper and 100% / Actual Size.
Turn off Fit to Page. Print pages 2 and 3.
Check the 50 mm ruler before you start.

2 Make it yours

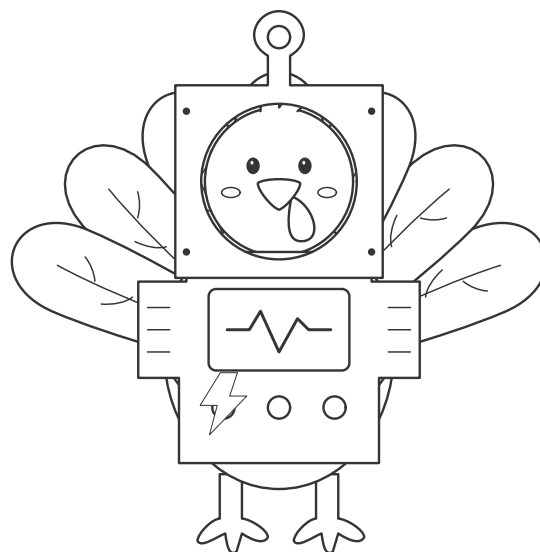
Color before cutting if using color-in.
Try pencils, crayons or washable markers.

3 Cut the pieces

Cut around the outside of the turkey.
Cut the 3 costume pieces on page 3.
Keep inner details; cut windows only if marked.

4 Build your character

Glue the control panel over the body.
An adult cuts out the round face window.
Add the frame, then the lightning badge.



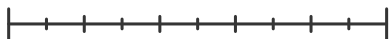
ROBOT IN DISGUISE

A tiny supply list

Paper / Printer / Scissors / Glue stick / Coloring supplies (optional)

An adult should help with cutting. Try each piece before gluing it down.

PRINT CHECK



This line must measure 50 mm.

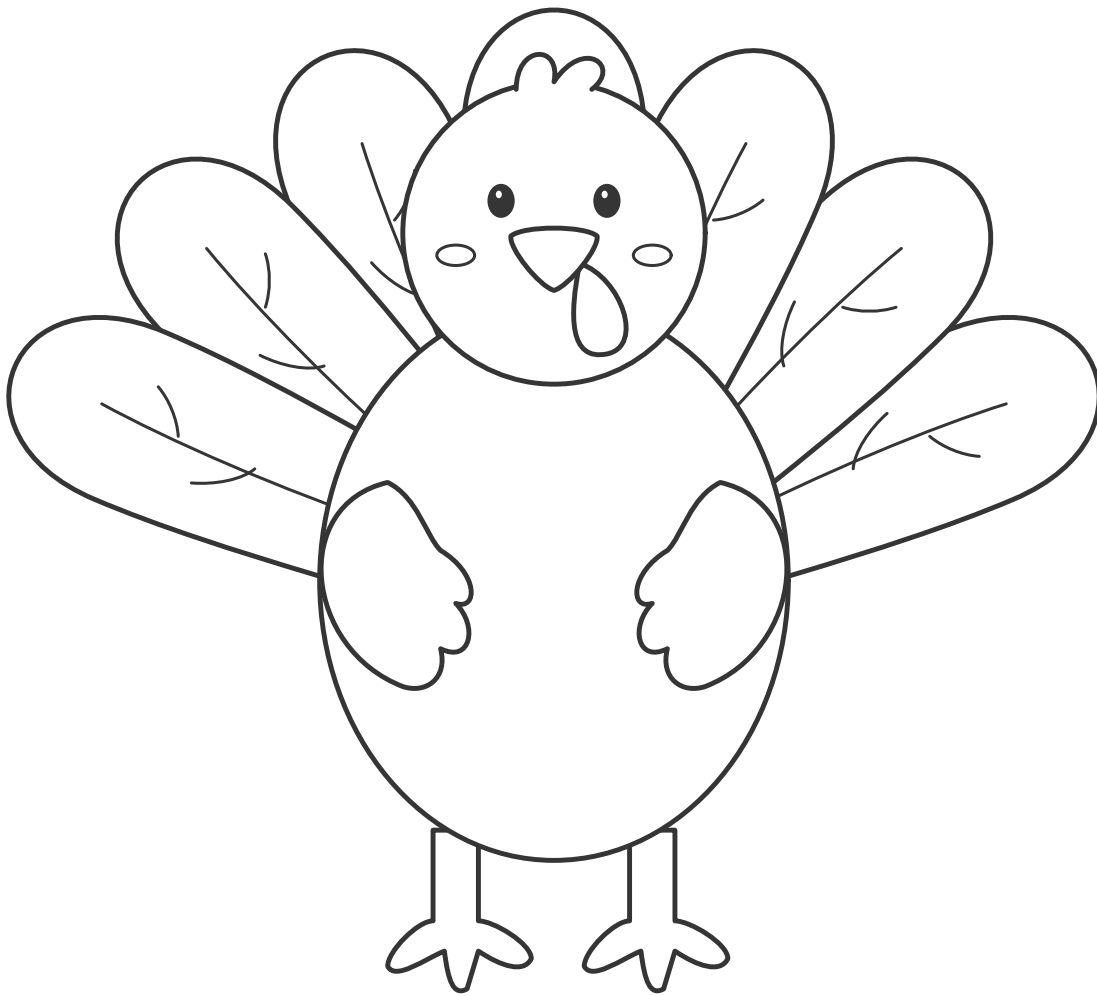
Use the included turkey base.

Keep paper size and print scale the same.

Class assignment? Check teacher directions.

Meet your undercover turkey.

Cut only around the outside. Keep the face, feathers and feet together.

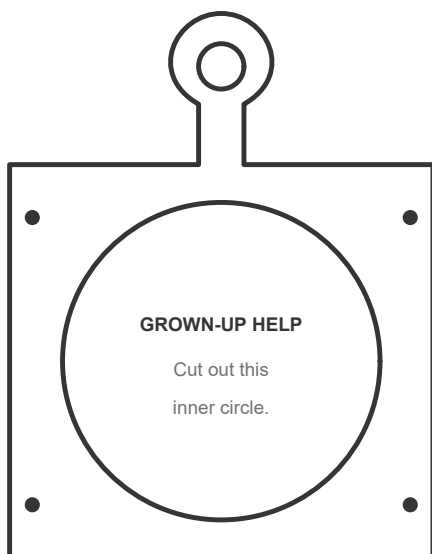


TURKEY BASE / 100% ACTUAL SIZE

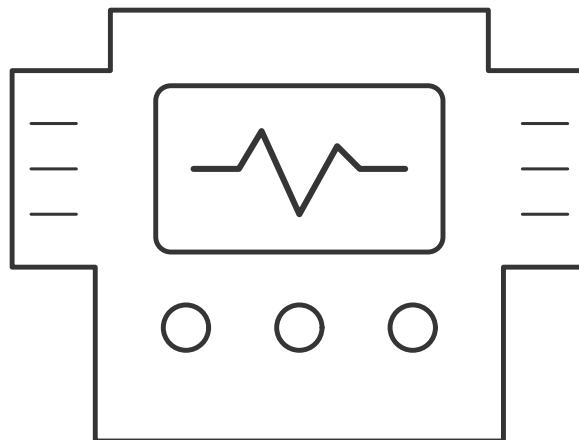
The same original base fits every Little Disguises kit.

Three pieces. A new personality.

Cut on the outside edges. The thin inner lines are details to keep.



01 ANTENNA FACE FRAME

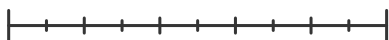


02 CONTROL-PANEL BODY

PRINT CHECK



This line must measure 50 mm.

Tip: dry-fit, then glue.

All pieces fit the base on page 2.
